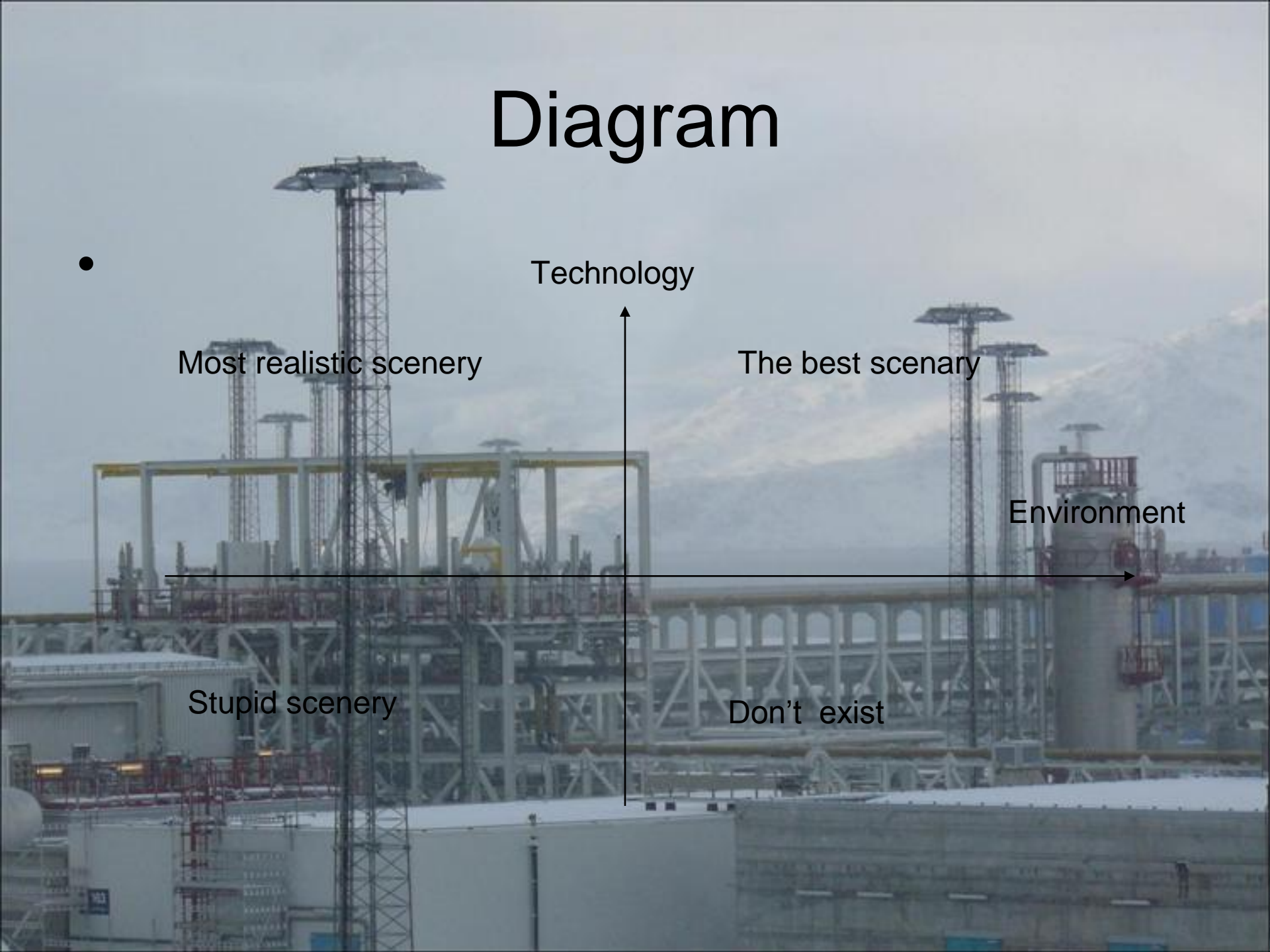

# ++ The best scenario
